The festival lasts for three days with houses and temples beautifully decorated.

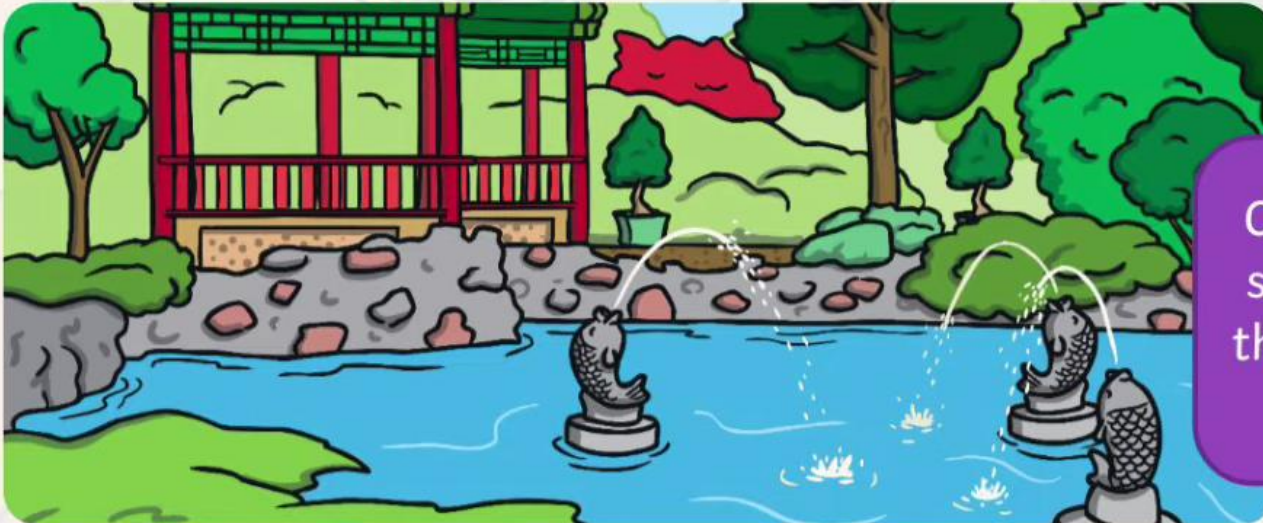

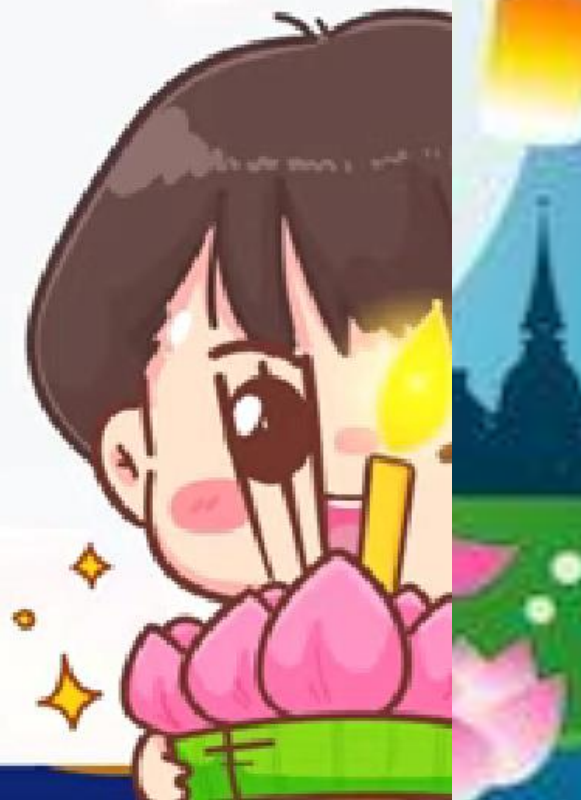

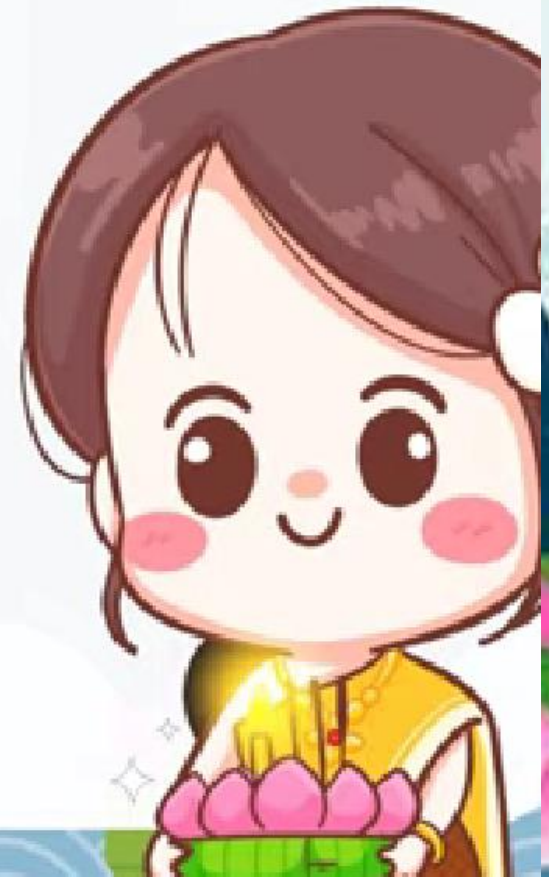
